



REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS

The City of Wheeling will be accepting proposals for Patterson Pony Baseball Field Renovation (Large Field). This project will focus on infield renovations with an area of 11500 square feet. Coordinates: 40.036306, -80.661104, with approximate address of 21 Sycamore Avenue, Wheeling, WV 26003.



Project Specifications:

- Mobilize to site.
- Excavate as necessary, approximately sq.ft. to depth of approximately inches.
- Transport material to field from staging site.
- Import and apply 5 loads(s) of Fielder's Choice PRO RED Infield Mix or equivalent.
- Remove existing lip at infield radius and define turf edges.
- Laser grade utilizing a dual plane laser-controlled system to provide positive surface drainage. Compact and finish drag.
- Rebuild pitcher's mound utilizing packing clays.
- Rebuild batter's boxes with packing clays.
- Install 1 set(s) of base anchors in concrete at proper dimensions.
- Apply and incorporate 2 tons of 50/50 Conditioner – Pro's Choice/Diamond Pro or equivalent.
- Clean up and demobilize from site.

Included:

- 1 each – Pro Hollywood Style Bases or equivalent (Set of 3)
- 3 each – 1.5” Anchor in Concrete
- 3 each – 1.5” Foam Base Plugs
- 1 pcs. – 24” Four-way Pitching Rubber
- 1 pcs. – In-Ground HP – Rubber Core

We are looking to have this project finished as soon as possible, weather permitting. Please provide a project timeline for projected start and completion with proposal.
