City to Co-Host Public Meeting on Mobility, Streetscape Study

WHEELING, W.Va. – The City of Wheeling, West Virginia Department of Transportation, and Belomar Regional Council will collaboratively hold a public meeting on Wednesday, May 9, 2018, from 5:00 to 7:00 p.m. at West Virginia Northern Community College in the auditorium, located in the B&O Building.

Officials will present preliminary findings from a study of improvement concepts for Main and Market streets in Downtown Wheeling, including a potential conversion to two-way traffic. The study is part of an ongoing Downtown Wheeling streetscape improvement project that is under development by WVDOT District 6.

The scheduled public meeting is from 5:00 to 7:00 p.m., and the public will be afforded the opportunity to ask questions and give written comments on the project throughout the meeting. At 5:30 p.m., the project consultant will make a brief presentation to explain the downtown mobility and streetscape study process and the options under consideration.
