PROBATIONARY FIREFIGHTER

QUALIFICATIONS: Applicants must be a citizen of the United States; be 18-35 years of age; possess a high school diploma or equivalent and a valid driver's license. Must become a resident of the City of Wheeling, Ohio County, or certain portions of Marshall County and Brooke County within six months of employment.

SALARY: Starting salary \$33,410 plus benefits: \$34,443 after successful completion of one year probationary period.

The written portion of the test is to be given on **Wednesday, September 18, 2013 at 6:00 p.m.** at Wheeling Park White Palace, Wheeling, WV. The agility portion of the examination will be given on **Saturday, October 19, 2013.**

Applications may be obtained Monday through Friday beginning July 1, 2013 during the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. at the City of Wheeling, Human Resources Department, City-County Building, Room 301, 1500 Chapline Street, Wheeling, WV 26003.

New hires will be required to obtain their paramedic certification within a maximum of four years from their hire date.

Probationary Firefighter applicants who possess a current Paramedic Certification and who pass all of the other requirements of a Probationary Firefighter, will be given priority in hiring.

A fee of \$20.00 payable to "City of Wheeling" is due upon return of completed application. Fee includes cost of study guide.

The Fire Civil Service Commission will be awarding veteran's preference points in accordance with §6-13-1 of WV State Code. Applicants who wish to be considered for veteran's preference points should submit a DD-214 or other suitable military documentation with the application. Failure to submit documentation by the deadline date will waive your eligibility for veteran's preference points for this examination.

Last date to file applications and military verification is **Monday, July 15, 2013 at 4:00 p.m.**
