### City of Wheeling Hosts Double Feature Weekend *Free Movies at Heritage Port, Centre Market*

This special double feature will kick off on Friday, July 28, with *Sing* (PG) at Heritage Port at 9:30 p.m. Before the movie, kids can participate in a pre-movie craft activity starting at 8:00 p.m. Supplies will be provided to make your own maracas as a tie-in to the movie.

Due to rescheduling, volunteers from the Vineyard Church are not available to serve free popcorn this weekend; however, Williams Lea Tag has expanded their sponsorship to provide attendees with a treat from Mmm Popcorn on Friday night. Buttered popcorn will be free, and Mmm Popcorn will be on site to sell a few specialty flavors at a reduced price.

Saturday, July 29, *La La Land* (PG-13) will be shown at Centre Market at 9:30 p.m. The screen will be set up near Antiques on the Market facing north. Guests are encouraged to come to Centre Market early for dinner or drinks at the local eateries and enjoy an evening under the stars. Attendees will need to bring their own chairs for the movie.

This is the first time the City has hosted movie night at Centre Market. Due to a full Heritage Port summer schedule, it was necessary to find an alternate venue when the movie had to be rescheduled.
