### **CITY COLLECTING FEEDBACK ON SUMMER FESTIVAL SEASON**

**Wheeling, WV** – The City of Wheeling is conducting an online survey to gather feedback on the 2012 summer events schedule. The survey is open to the public until Monday, October 1, at 5:00 p.m.

People can access the survey in one of three ways:

The survey asks which events people enjoyed the most as well as what types of events could be added to the schedule in the future. Those who participate in the survey have the chance to express any overall concerns or complaints with the festivals and offer suggestions for improvement.

The 10-question survey also prompts people to consider what they would do with \$15,000 to put toward Heritage Port events. The money is only hypothetical at this point, but the question is already generating some creative ideas.

The 2012 Wheeling Summer Events Schedule was released in late April and listed events at Heritage Port, the Tuesday concert venues in Warwood and Wheeling Park, and the Anne Kuchinka Amphitheater in Oglebay. After nearly 70 total events, the Wheeling Heritage Port Sternwheel Festival closed out the city's festival season on September 15.
