Wheeling HRC Partners with WV HRC, EEOC, NAACP for Community Presentation

Wheeling, WV – The Wheeling Human Rights Commission (HRC) is partnering with the West Virginia Human Rights Commission (WV HRC), the U.S. Equal Employment Opportunity Commission (EEOC), and the Wheeling Branch of the National Association for the Advancement of Colored People (NAACP) to make a joint presentation to the Wheeling community and offer agency availability to Wheeling area residents.

On Monday, November 16, 2015, beginning at 6:00 p.m., in the West Virginia Northern Community College B&O Auditorium, representatives from the Wheeling HRC, WV HRC, EEOC, and NAACP will give individual presentations to the community. Following, until 8:00 p.m., each agency will be available to talk with interested persons about any discrimination concerns and how complaints of discrimination may be filed.

The Wheeling HRC, a commission of the City of Wheeling, strives to eliminate all discrimination in housing, employment and places of public accommodations in the city of Wheeling, and investigates complaints of discrimination within the city.

The WV HRC investigates and adjudicates complaints in housing, employment and places of public accommodations, and strives to eliminate discrimination throughout the state of West Virginia.

The EEOC promotes equality of opportunity in the workplace and enforces federal laws prohibiting employment discrimination.

The NAACP works to ensure a society in which all individuals have equal rights without discrimination.
