AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WHEELING
APPROVING AND ADOPTING THE 2023 REPLACEMENT PAGES TO THE
CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF WHEELING.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WHEELING:

WHEREAS, certain provisions within the Codified Ordinances should be amended to conform with current State law; and

WHEREAS, various ordinances of a general and permanent nature have been passed by Council which should be included in the Codified Ordinances; and

WHEREAS, Council has heretofore entered into a contract with the Walter H. Drane Company to prepare and publish such revision which is before Council;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WHEELING:

Section 1. That the ordinances of the City of Wheeling, of a general and permanent nature, as revised, recodified, rearranged and consolidated into component codes, chapters, articles and sections within the 2023 Replacement Pages to the Codified Ordinances are hereby approved and adopted.

Section 2. That the following sections and articles are hereby added, amended or repealed as respectively indicated in order to comply with current State law:

4(b): Section 3. Pursuant to Section 7 of the Charter and West Virginia Code Section 8-11-

- (a) Notice of the proposed adoption of the current Replacement Pages to the Codified Ordinances shall be given by publication as provided in West Virginia Code Section 8-11-4(a)(2);
- (b) One book-form copy of the current Replacement Pages to the Codified Ordinances shall be certified as correct by the Mayor through authentication of this ordinance and filed as a permanent record in the office of the City Clerk.

Section 4. This ordinance shall be effective from and after the date of its passage, subject to the provisions of Section 2.
