## PUBLIC NOTICE FY 2023 ANNUAL ACTION PLAN

The Council of the City of Wheeling, West Virginia will hold a public hearing on **Tuesday**, April 18, **2023 at 5:30 p.m.**, prevailing time, in the Wheeling City Council Chambers located on the first floor of the City-County Building, 1500 Chapline Street, Wheeling, West Virginia. The purpose for the hearing is to present the City's Fiscal Year 2023 Annual Action Plan for the use of the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) and the HOME Investment Partnership (HOME) funds. The City intends to submit its Fiscal Year 2023 Annual Action Plan in the amounts of \$1,140,498 for the CDBG Program and \$385,214 for the HOME Program to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD).

The City-County Building and the City Council Chambers are accessible to persons with disabilities. It is anticipated that at its May 2, 2023 meeting, Wheeling City Council will approve and adopt the Fiscal Year 2023 Annual Action Plan and will authorize the proper City Officials to submit the application of grant funds to HUD for Fiscal Year 2023 on or before May 15, 2023.

If the City were to undertake an activity that would result in the displacement of individuals or families, then the City would utilize its policy for minimizing such displacement. Also, the City is responsible for replacing all occupied low- and moderate-income housing units that may be demolished or converted as a result of the use of CDBG funds.

All interested residents are encouraged to attend this public hearing and they will be given the opportunity to present oral or written testimony concerning the proposed use of CDBG and HOME funds under the Fiscal Year 2023 Annual Action Plan.
