#### FY 2021, 2022, AND 2024 PROGRAM YEARS - CDBG Funds

### A. EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

It is necessary for the City of Wheeling to process "Substantial Amendments" to the City's FY 2021, 2022, and 2024 Annual Action Plans for the use of Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds. In accordance with CDBG Program Regulations, the City is allowed to make Substantial Amendments to its Annual Plans and Budgets in accordance with the City's Citizen Participation Plan.

The City has determined that it is necessary to amend the previously approved CDBG program years' budgets to modify the amount of funds allocated to specific projects. These are considered substantial amendments in accordance with the City's Citizen Participation Plan as the following applies: change in allocation priorities and proposing an undertaking not previously described in the Annual Action Plan.

The following Resolution will be proposed for consideration by the Wheeling City Council during its Regular Meeting on Tuesday, January 6, 2026.

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WHEELING, OHIO COUNTY APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE SUBMITTAL TO THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING AND URBAN DEVELOPMENT (HUD) OF SUBSTANTIAL AMENDMENTS TO THE FY 2021, FY 2022 AND FY 2024 ANNUAL ACTION PLANS FOR THE USE OF COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT (CDBG) FUNDS

WHEREAS, under Title I of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974, as amended, the Secretary of the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development is authorized to extend financial assistance to communities in the prevention or elimination of slums or urban blight, or activities which will benefit low- and moderate-income persons, or other urgent community development needs; and

WHEREAS, the City of Wheeling had previously approved the budgets and Annual Action Plans for Fiscal Years 2021, 2022, 2024, which proposed how entitlement grant funds would be expended to address the housing and community development needs identified in the City's Five-Year Consolidated Plan; and

WHEREAS, HUD permits grant recipients to revise and amend its previous budgets and Annual Action Plans; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with the Federal Regulations governing the CDBG Program, certain changes and revisions to an Annual Action Plan may be considered a Substantial Amendment as outlined in the City of Wheeling's Citizen Participation Plan; and

WHEREAS, a draft of the Substantial Amendments to the FY 2021, FY 2022 and FY 2024 Annual Action Plans was on public display from Thursday, November 27, 2025 through Monday, December 29, 2025 and the City held a public hearing on Tuesday, December 16, 2025 concerning said amendments, and the comments of various agencies, groups, and citizens were taken into consideration in the preparation of the final Substantial Amendment document.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WHEELING, OHIO COUNTY, WEST VIRGINIA, AS FOLLOWS:
