
NOTICE OF DISPLAY OF FY 2026 ANNUAL ACTION PLAN AND PUBLIC HEARING CITY OF WHEELING, WEST VIRGINIA

The City of Wheeling, West Virginia will hold a public hearing on Tuesday, May 5, 2026 at 5:30 p.m., prevailing time, in Council Chambers, Room 103, City-County Building, 1500 Chapline Street, Wheeling, West Virginia. The purpose of the hearing is to present the City's Fiscal Year (FY) 2026 Annual Action Plan for the use of Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Program and HOME Investment Partnership (HOME) Program funds. The City intends to submit to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) its FY 2026 Annual Action Plan for the formula allocation amounts of \$1,117,470.00 under the CDBG Program and \$331,528.92 under the HOME Program.

To obtain the view of residents, agencies, organizations, and other interested parties, the City has placed the draft FY 2026 Annual Action Plan on display for a period of thirty (30) days starting Friday, April 17, 2026 through Monday, May 18, 2026 during normal hours of operation, at the following locations:

Additionally, the draft FY 2026 Annual Action Plan is on public display on the City's website: www.wheelingwv.gov.

It is anticipated that at its Tuesday, May 19, 2026 regular meeting, Wheeling City Council will consider a Resolution to adopt the FY 2026 Annual Action Plan and authorize the proper City Officials to submit the FY 2026 application for grant funds to HUD on or before June 12, 2026. Should City Council remove a proposed activity included in the draft plan, the associated funds will be reallocated to eligible activities through a future substantial amendment to the FY 2026 Annual Action Plan.

If the City were to undertake an activity that would result in the displacement of individuals or families, then the City would utilize its policy for minimizing such displacement. Also, the City is responsible for replacing all occupied low- and moderate-income housing units that may be demolished or converted as a result of the use of CDBG funds.

All interested residents are encouraged to attend this public hearing and they will be given the opportunity to present oral or written testimony concerning the proposed use of CDBG and HOME funds under the FY 2026 Annual Action Plan.
