Dear Mr. Herron:

My operating budget request has not changed signifyingly since last year. I am requesting an increase in advertising/publishing for legal ads. We are currently 50% through the fiscal year and I am at 68% of my budget for that line item. This is used for legal ads. Being proactive for next year I am asking for a \$500 increase. I am also asking for an increase in telephone for the same underlying reason; 50% through the fiscal year, and I have already exceeded my allotment. The addition of a city cell phone is new to this role and I believe it helps me better serve and stay engaged with citizens.

As I progress in my role, I have clarity on two undertakings I would like to see come to fruition. I am working with organizations on the state and national level to earn my certification. To earn Certified Municipal Clerk status, I need to complete ample amounts of educational and experience training hours. During this past year I have been able to complete a lot, but am still short on certification status. I have asked for an increase in travel expenses to attend National Municipal Clerks Conference and learn from others around the country, complementing attending West Virginia Municipal League conferences.

In addition to personal education and growth I would like to continue to make records transparent and easily available to the public. Our vault houses Wheeling's rich and abundant history and I want to make every effort to preserve it. There are several local organizations and historians that are interested in helping with this project. However, before any action can be taken there needs to be an inventory conducted on all information contained within the vault. Archivist from Ohio County Public Library, Wheeling Area Genealogy Society, and Wheeling Heritage have all expressed interest in this project and motivated for its success.
