Wheeling City Council Meetings Returning to Council Chambers

WHEELING, W.VA. – Following two months of virtual interactions due to the COVID-19 pandemic, Wheeling City Council meetings will return to Council Chambers beginning at 5:30 p.m., Tuesday, June 16. A finance committee meeting will precede the council meeting at 5:15 p.m.

City Clerk Brenda Delbert explained that while the meetings will be occurring in-person, proper precautions will be taken.

“All of those in attendance at the meetings will be required to wear a mask. The Wheeling-Ohio County Health Department will be providing hand sanitizer and extra masks for those who may need one,” she said. “Additionally, we will be practicing social distancing while in council chambers.”
