Wheeling Planning Commission to Conduct Meeting Virtually

WHEELING, W.VA. – In light of the COVID-19 pandemic and the government Orders restricting gatherings, the Wheeling Planning Commission's upcoming meeting will be held virtually and not in City Council Chambers where they are usually conducted.

Slated for 5 p.m., Monday, April 6, the web meeting will be live streamed on the *Wheeling WV City Government* Facebook page.

Assistant Director of Economic & Community Development Tom Connelly explained the public will still have the opportunity to observe the proceedings and provide input where appropriate.

Connelly said the other two agenda items are not public hearings, so comments will not be taken, however citizens are still able to observe the proceedings as with any public meeting.
